The Presenter

Australian born to a Native American Indian mother and a Portuguese father, Lilli Rodrigues-Pang grew up on a diet of story, mythology and language. Lilli is a bilingual storyteller (Spanish and English) but includes many languages in her tales as she honours the people of the world and the stories they have to tell. Lili has performed at a number of national events and venues including: The Sydney Opera House, The Dreaming Festival, The National Folk Festival at Monkey Baa Theatre, Riverside Theatre, The Casula Powerhouse and many more. Internationally she has performed most recently in India, USA, Iran, Columbia, Peru, Singapore and Malaysia as she travels to share her love of story and performance.
