So when Eliza logs on to find her avatar has been changed, her world's been messed up and horrible messages have been sent from her account, Eliza has to convince her teacher it wasn't her, and confess she has been a bad friend. This play looks at the perils of sharing passwords with your best friend and the consequences of being the bully.

15 minutes with Improv Workshop

Katie has been bugging her parents to get her own Instagram account. They think she's too young, but they submit. It seems like such a wonderful new world for Katie, but does she know what she's getting into with all these applications and all these offers from new friends? And most importantly, do you accept a follow request from a person you've never met? All the questions a kid would never ask their parent, and the answers they need to know.

Improv Workshop: Students will role-play different online characters and an audience poll will determine the people that are safe or risky to befriend online, reinforcing conscious decision-making in all aspects of personal safety.

Choose your own Cyber Adventure

20 minutes with Forum Style Workshop

Hayley needs the audience help her work her way through the world of the internet. She has just started live gaming and she loves to talk to her friends on live chat. She's even made a new friend who says they live close and even though they haven't met before, he wants them to meet at the park. Here the audience will help Hayley as she travels the new world of cyberspace.

Forum Syle Workshop: is incorporated into the performance allowing students to stop the play at 3 critical points and change the outcome. The focus is on 5 key rules for online safety that form the groundwork for *Netiquette*, with visual cues and call and response audience interaction.
